## **VANCOUVER ACUTE (8 projects)**

- **Dr. Kristy Wang (Fellow) (Medicine):** Increasing Home at Health (HaH) census to over 90% capacity by boosting referral and patient acceptance.
- **Dr. Chantalle Grant (Surgery):** Decreasing inpatient length of stay for gallbladder disease patients at VGH.
- **Dr. Andrew Gilloolyn (Fellow) (Surgery):** Reducing unnecessary perioperative narcotic use in post-transplant liver patients at VGH.
- **Dr. Marnie Wilson (Critical Care):** Recruit and see 80% of eligible critical care survivors in the CCRP clinic at Vancouver General Hospital
- Dr. Bradley Locke (Psychiatry): Improve psychiatrist on-call process to enhance patient flow by reducing time between ERP note and psychiatry disposition at VGH
- **Dr. Renelle Myers: (Medicine):** Increase the number of patients screened by IPNs who have had prior CT scans at VGH
- **Dr. Rachel Liu Hennessey (Surgery):** Increase the percentage of patients receiving multidisciplinary assessment before major hernia repair at VGH
- Dr. Mosaed Aldekhayel (Fellow) (Surgery): Reduce the length of stay for patients undergoing Whipple procedure at VGH

- **Dr. Melissa Aragon Cantu (Family Medicine):** Support marginalized patients in Squamish in accessing wound care to reduce ER visits
- **Dr. Mireille Potentier (Internal Medicine):** Decrease surgical cancellations in elective orthopaedic patients with heart failure, hypertension, and diabetes at LGH.



- Dr. Esaba Kashem (Palliative Medicine): Improve sleep among patients admitted to the Palliative Care Unit at RH
- **Lindsay Popit (Nurse Practitioner):** Decrease wait time for treatment callback for GAS infections at Richmond City Centre UPCC.
- Dr. Bella Wu (Surgery): Optimize ENT surgical tray use at RH ED to reduce unused instruments, cut second tray openings, replace single-use plastics, and improve efficiency.
