The North Shore services over 190,000 residents in the communities of North Vancouver, West Vancouver, Bowen Island and Lions Bay. Here, more than 2,600 employees work with over 200 family physicians and specialists to provide high quality healthcare and support. Programs and services are delivered around the needs of patients, clients, residents and their families as they move through all stages of care, treatment, rehabilitation and recovery.

We have some of the mildest weather in Canada with the coastal marine climate softening the effects of Canadian winters. Prepare to fall in love. Year-round nature trails, seaside strolls as well as winter downhill and cross-country skiing are literally minutes from your doorstep. Healthcare Facilities

Acute Care Services – Lions Gate Hospital, the fourth busiest hospital in the Lower Mainland, provides a range of services including general medicine, critical care, emergency, general surgery, orthopedics, maternity, pediatrics, palliative care and rehabilitative services. In a year, the hospital has approximately 178,000 patient visits. There are currently seven ORs at Lions Gate Hospital, plus three for specialized *ad hoc* surgical procedures. Surgical services include general surgery, ophthalmology, urology, endoscopy, gynecology, ENT, vascular, orthopedic and plastic surgery. Lions Gate Hospital is one of only five neurosurgery centres in BC. State-of-the-art Brain Lab technology has been introduced recently to the neuro unit allowing surgeons to use 3D brain image scans during operations.

Residential Care – Here, the focus is on both private and public residential care facilities that offer extended, intermediate and multi-level care. Together, the facilities provide over 1,300 residential care beds.

Community Health – This area encompasses public health, home support, continuing care, mental health and adult day centres, along with a range of other services and supports for the community. Most of the Community Health staff spend their time working in the community to support clients and their families at home, in schools and at other community sites.



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
