SUNSHINE COAST

Gibsons, BC and Sechelt, BC

The Sunshine Coast peninsula is one of BC's most scenic regions, accessible from the mainland by a 40-minute ferry ride. A backdrop of the majestic Coastal Mountain Range frames a myriad of bike and cross-country skiing trails and miles of sandy beaches. The area is home to nearly 29,000 people concentrated around the larger town centres of Sechelt, Gibsons Landing and Pender Harbour. The peninsula attracts people looking for a friendlier, more relaxed lifestyle. Whether you settle in a town centre or choose a rural setting, you're always close to a wonderful array of social, cultural and recreational activities.

Health Care Services

Sechelt Hospital is a 32-bed acute care hospital serving the entire Sunshine Coast. The hospital provides acute medical, surgical and obstetrical inpatient/outpatient services, supported by laboratory, diagnostic imaging and rehabilitation services. It is also home to a 4-bed critical care unit.

Mental Health and Addictions Services are structured with an integrated multidisciplinary team approach. St. Mary's is pleased to support a 6-bed inpatient Psychiatric Unit for the Sunshine Coast.

Shorncliffe Intermediate Care Facility provides the elders of the community with a safe and secure home-like environment. The facility consists of 59 private rooms, including 2 community hospice rooms, access to spacious grounds and an atmosphere that promotes resident, family and staff participation and growth in a person-centered care environment.

Totem Lodge, situated beside Sechelt Hospital, is an extended care facility that accommodates 43 of the community's elders in a setting that provides stimulation, socialization, and activities designed to encourage the residents, family and staff to participate and grow in a person-centered environment. The facility also provides 6 sub-acute beds for St. Mary's Hospital Acute Care.

Home and Community Care Services are designed to supplement, rather than replace, the efforts of individuals to care for themselves at home with assistance of family, friends and community. Community Health Workers, Home Care Nurses, Case Managers, and Rehabilitation workers offer their services to the Sunshine Coast area.

Gibsons and Sechelt Health Units provide an array of public health and preventative services including health protection, health promotion and prevention and early intervention services. The unit is staffed with public health nurses, nurse practitioner, environmental health officers, dietitians, speech-language pathologists, audiologist, needle exchange workers, licensing officers, lactation consultants, community developers, tobacco reduction coordinators, and support staff.
